Share our knowledge: We want to make our effective working methods and models available for others to use wherever they are.

Reasons to celebrate!

We thank Jesus for each life that has been turned around, each family that has been rebuilt, each community that is better able to provide for itself and each person who has come to know him.

We are seeing people become "Oaks of Righteousness" at every level of our work. Every Life Group is led by 1 or 2 volunteers who want to see Jesus in their community. Impact Team members give their time, travelling far and wide to share the work of Dignity because they have seen it make a difference. Bernard has become our Impact Team Coordinator and we want to raise others up to work with him. We estimate that 16,708 hours were volunteered in Zambia last year. Our work has started a movement!

Women are being valued equally to men breaking the norm of rural village life. By translating our teaching sessions and materials into their language and by using simple working methods we have opened the door for women to be involved where they have previously been excluded due to typically lower education levels and cultural expectations. **Men and women working together are stronger!**

We believe there are 500 Life Groups! At the end of August when we did our last formal count there were 482 groups. Impact Teams have since reported more groups beginning and we believe that takes us past the 500 mark! **That means between 7,500 and 10,000 people getting to know Jesus better!**

Collective responsibility is taking the place of a dependancy mindset. Instead of waiting for someone else to come and help, Life Groups are stepping up and working together to tackle the challenges faced by their communities. Life Groups members are living **Amazing Lives** and being part of **Everyday Miracles**.
