Challenge Details

Saturday 9th June: Meet at the [Burbage Bridge car park](#) (click link for map, Ringinglow Rd, Hope Valley S32 1BR) at 8am and the day will be done by 6.30pm!

What to expect on the day: The day will involve completing a 10 mile circuit on foot and climbing 10 graded rock climbs all inside 10 hours. This is an excellent Peak District challenge and mini-adventure. No previous experience is necessary. We will provide all the kit, expertise and plenty of encouragement. You just turn up, climb, walk, climb, walk, climb, walk....you get the idea...and take in the beautiful scenery of the Peak District.

Cost: £50/person - due at time of booking.

Transport: Transport is not included. If you need a lift to the challenge do let us know and we will do our best to put you in touch with someone else taking on the challenge who can offer you a lift.

Accommodation: We think this challenge can be completed in a day trip from Manchester so we have not included accommodation in the plans or cost. If you'd like to arrange your own accommodation, you are welcome to do so. Information of some local places to stay are included on the final page.

Children: Children are welcome to take part in this event. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian (with parent's written permission).

Meet Moses...



Moses is a part of a Dignity Impact Team and he plants and supports Life Groups, small Christian led community discipleship groups to which everyone is welcome.

'I found that most churches are just in town, forgetting the people in the villages and not bringing any change to the villages.'

In 2015 he partnered with Dignity to do something about this and started planting Life Groups in the communities around where he lives.

'Since we started with Dignity we are seeing communities appreciating the teaching and learning to relate to God. They are special people of God. They are seeing that God can use them in their villages!'
