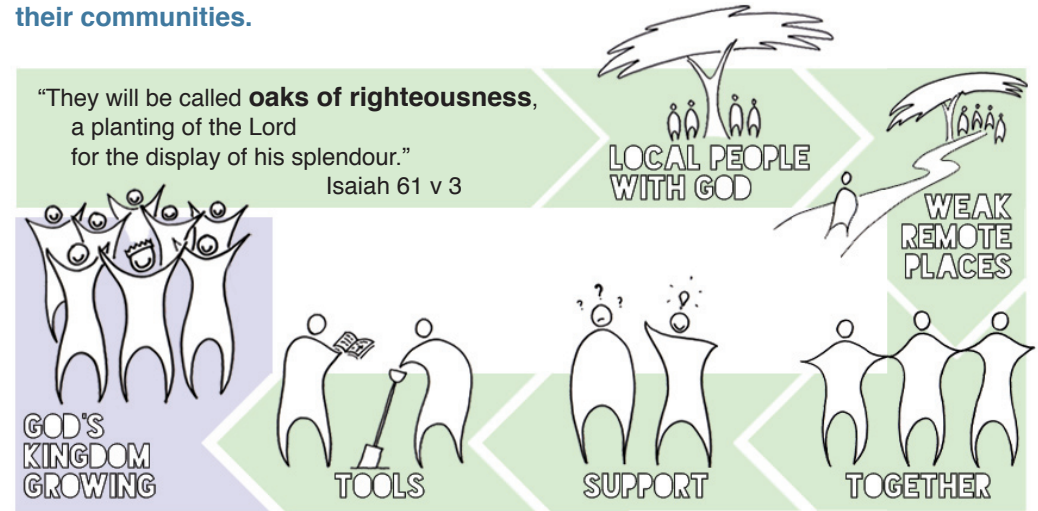
**Esther**

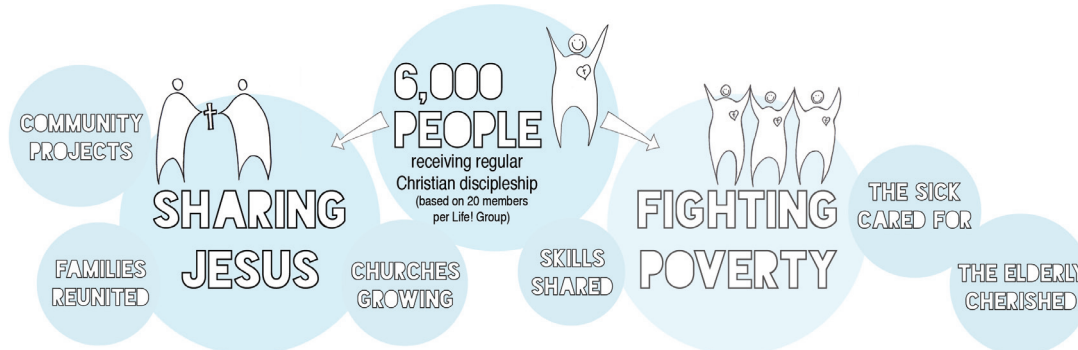

Dignity believes that each and every person is uniquely placed by God to reach those around them. We work to unite, equip and empower people to reach their God-given potential. Through Jesus, the people we work with are transforming their communities.



Today, there are over 300 Life Groups meeting in rural areas of sub-Saharan Africa. Life Groups explore what it means to follow Jesus, creating places for an estimated 6,000\* people to explore loving God and loving their neighbours. God's people working together in community are bringing life to everyone.

A Life Group helped Christopher overcome his addiction to alcohol. Two brothers were helped to heal a 25 year division in their family. Osia has learnt conservation farming techniques and is now teaching these to other Life Groups. All these people and many more are meeting Jesus and finding hope in their everyday lives through Life Groups!



\*A mature Life Group will have between 10 and 30 members. We estimate the membership of groups by assuming 20 people in each Life Group.
