1. Mlango, Kenya: 22nd - 25th July

We are following up an invite from Open Arms International to share the vision of Life Groups with the community surrounding the Open Arms Village.

2. Ganze, Kenya: 29th July - 1st August

7 Life Groups began here after an initial visit by the Dignity team. Working with existing Life Group leaders, we will help them facilitate training for others interested in planting Life Groups.

3. Mbeya, Tanzania: 7th - 10th August

37 Life Groups have begun around Mbeya. We will be working with the local team to help them make strategic plans and share the role of leadership with others.

4. Lusaka, Zambia: 21st - 22nd August

Together with Zambian team members and Kate, Jan and Katy (UK volunteers) we will receive safeguarding training from Tehila, a Zambian organisation working to protect children. Together, we will develop a safeguarding policy for Impact Teams.

5. Mkushi, Zambia: 26th - 29th August

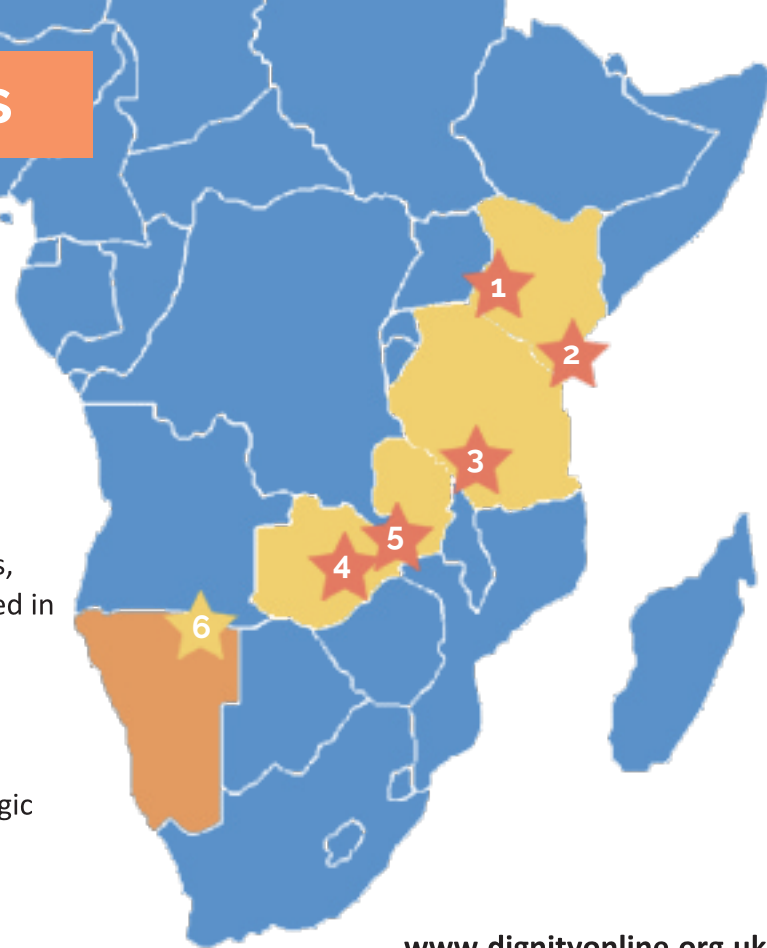
With a wider group of Zambian team members, we will work to apply the safeguarding training to their regular activities. We will intertwine this with an introduction to Love Your Children and work to develop this resource with the input of the Zambian team.

6. Jon & Jude Witt: Rundu, Namibia: October

Jon & Jude will be working to build on the initial work of Life Groups in and around Rundu and across the Angolan border.
